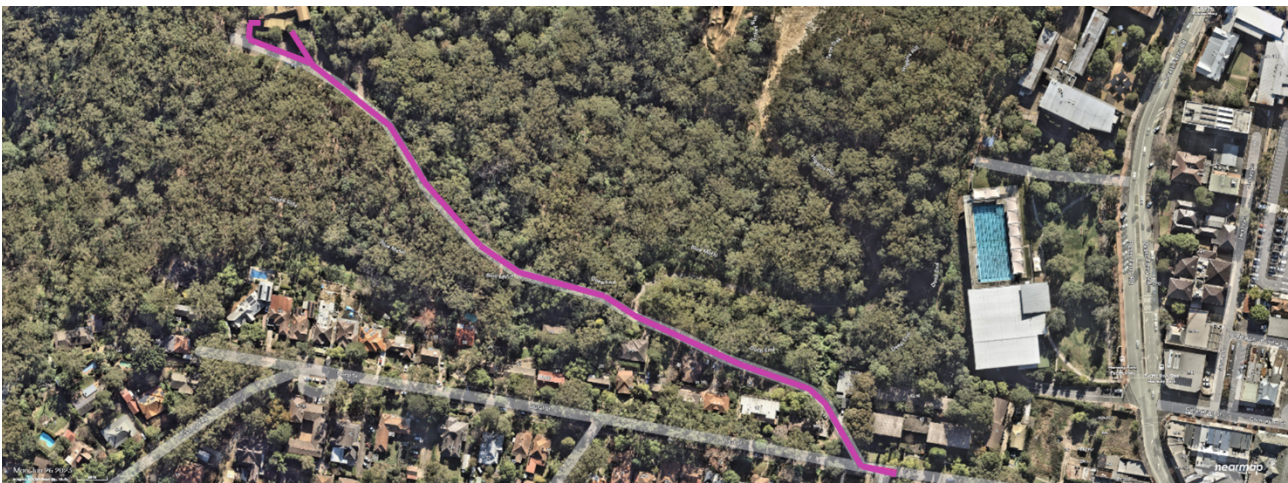
Utility services work on Quarry Road & Dural Street, Hornsby

Hornsby Shire Council has commenced utilities work at the western end of Quarry Road as part of the future development of the former quarry site.

Works will include the installation of:

- Ausgrid cables, conduits and low voltage distribution pillars;
- Street lights;
- Water and sewerage infrastructure;
- NBN conduits; and
- Water hydrant services for firefighting purposes.

The purple line on the image below shows the full extent of the works:



Work will be progressing eastwards over the coming weeks. Dependant on the weather and whether or not the trenching is through rock, works are expected to be completed by the end of July.

During the works, Quarry Road will be closed on weekdays (initially from the fire trail westwards) to ensure a safe working site. Access to properties and pedestrian access to the bushwalks will be maintained at all times. Access to the mountain bike tracks will be via the fire trail entry points. The road will be reopened each weekend.

When the works reach the junction of Quarry Road, Dural Street and Frederick Street, we will also need to close part of Dural Street and traffic detours and management will be in place. Property access will again be maintained at all times.

At this stage it is not possible to know the exact dates for the road closures, as progress will be weather and rock dependant.

The site approved working hours are from 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, with any high noise impact work restricted to 8am to 6pm.

Council apologises for any inconvenience that may be caused during the works.

We ask that each Property Owner(s) or Owners Corporation (Strata Management) ensure that all occupants are aware of this work.
